Route: Lowland Culture - Ecotourism
Duration: 1 day

PROGRAM

We meet in Rurrenabaque and ahead to harbor where a boat waits for us to take us for 40 minutes by Beni River in the jungle until San Miguel del Bala Eco-lodge. With a local guide will take a walk along a stream through the forest where they explain us about wildlife present during the trip. We arrive at a natural pool filled by crystalline water from a beautiful waterfall. There is time for a refreshing bath and to be given with the sharp water decline a back or feetmassage. Back on foot and by boat to the Eco-lodge where a delicious lunch prepared with local ingredients following a typical recipe.

In the afternoon we will begin with a short trek to San Miguel community. Here the guide explains about daily life, crops, building techniques, religion, crafts, customs and traditions from the place. A huge experience is the cane juice preparation in the mill. For those who know the first step in the long and heavy process of making sugar, never be the same sweeten your coffee. Return to Rurrenabaque at sunset.
